In these unprecedented times, we have implemented enhanced health and safety measures to help protect everyone. But we can't do it alone. Guest Responsibilities

- If you have a fever or are displaying other symptoms of COVID-19, please stay home.
- Wear face coverings per CDC guidelines
- Wash hands often with soap and water
- Avoid touching your face
- Maintain appropriate (6 ft.) distance from others not in your travel party

Here are the specific steps we're taking in accordance with state and federal guidelines.

- Hand washing stations are provided at 3 locations throughout both parks.
- We will be performing enhanced sanitizing throughout the day at these locations.
- Hand sanitizer is available at all porta potties and vendor booths.

Please read and follow all posted safety signage regarding masks and social distancing.

Limited Capacity: We adhere to CDC and Pa guidelines in the number of people permitted in the 4+ acres of the two parks area.

While we are committed to enhanced standards in an effort to keep you as healthy and safe as possible, there remains an inherent and elevated risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any public place and any place where people are present. People who do not show symptoms can still spread the Covid 19. COVID 19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.
